1. What will I learn on the course?

- Playing in tune and in time with other instrumentalists, and other ensemble skills
- Interpretation of repertoire in a range of styles
- Wind band repertoire, chosen to suit the range of instruments and playing standard of students

2. How will I learn?

You will learn through:

- Group rehearsal and tutor feedback to the ensemble and sections within it
- Individual practice of your parts outside class
- Observation and discussion of

3. How will I know I am making progress?

Regular feedback from the tutor

Self-assessment through learning statements and course evaluations

4. Are there any entry requirements?

At least two years' experience on your instrument is required.

5. What do I need to bring with me to class?

your own instrument

pencil and eraser for marking music

optional: a device to record music to help you learn your part

6. What next?

This course runs every term, and repertoire will change.

As you advance in skill on your instrument, you may also be interested in joining bands playing other styles of music, such as Big Band or Swing Band.

7. Does it matter if I miss a class?
